 - Incoming 4th grade students are encouraged to participate in the Summer Band Program to gain a good foundation for their first year of band.

Dear Middle School Parents and Guardians of incoming 5th graders, incoming 6th graders, incoming 7th graders, and incoming 8th graders,

ALL INCOMING 6TH GRADERS are required to have Tdap and Meningococcal vaccines. Proof of vaccination is due **September 1st**.
